Team Ireland Men's Archery Selection Criteria
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Introduction

Student Sport Ireland is the sole sanctioning body responsible for identifying, selecting and organising Irish teams and individuals to attend the 2015 FISU World University Games.

Events

Individual Events	
Men	- Recurve Bow (or division) - Compound Bow
Women	- Recurve Bow (or division) - Compound Bow
Team Events	
Men	- Recurve Bow - Compound Bow
Women	- Recurve Bow - Compound Bow
Mixed Team	- Recurve Bow - Compound Bow

Participation

Each country may enter a maximum of twelve (12) competitors.

2015 World University Games Archery Selection Criteria

To be considered for selection student athletes will be required to attain the following scores within the specified qualifying period.

Event	Men	Women
Compound	675/1350	660/1340
Recurve	640/1275	630/1260

Please note:

1. Scores to be shot at Archery Ireland or World Archery events WA720 or WA1440 rounds;
2. The last date for attaining the above scores is Sunday, the 31st May 2015
3. The qualifying period is 15 months prior to 31 May i.e. 1st March 2014 to 31st May 2015; however student archers qualifying on the basis of a having attained the qualifying score in 2014 must demonstrate consistency of performance to the Team Manager in the six months prior to the competition to secure a nomination to Student Sport Ireland.

Student Archer Selection

The Team Manager will submit to Student Sport Ireland the student archer list for participation at the 2015 World University Games. SSI High Performance Committee, aided by the selection criteria outlined above and student athlete nomination forms previously submitted, will review each student athlete nominated individually and ratify her/his nomination as appropriate.

Ultimately the decision of whether a student archer is selected for participation at the games rests with SSI High Performance Committee.

Eligibility: All students being considered to participate at the competition must meet the FISU and SSI Eligibility Criteria for International Competitions as published on the SSI web site: [Eligibility Criteria for International Competitions](#).

Age: The competitors must be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on 1st January 2015.

Delegation: Each country may enter a maximum of seventeen (17) persons of which twelve (12) are competitors and five (5) are officials.

Funding: Student Sport Ireland itself will not be in a position to provide any funding to support student athletes participating at the competition. While ultimately the cost of participation is the responsibility of the student athlete but in many instances the NGB does provide significant support. In addition the student's college may be in a position to also support his/her participation. It is advised that athletes under consideration approach their Sports Officer in their college to indicate their interest in participating in the event at the earliest opportunity and to determine if the College may be in a position to support their participation.
