Introduction

Student Sport Ireland is the sole sanctioning body responsible for identifying, selecting and organising Irish teams and individuals to attend the 2025 FISU World University Games.

Participation

Each country may enter a maximum of twelve (12) competitors with a maximum of three athletes in each bow category and gender three (3) RW, three (3) RM, three (3) CW, three (3) CM).

2025 World University Games Archery Selection Criteria

To be considered for selection student athletes will be required to attain the following scores within the specified qualifying period.

General Information

This policy should be read in conjunction with the Archery Ireland Selection criteria 2025. This can be found on <https://archery.ie/documents/> - **Note:** Article 6 of the Selection Criteria Rules does not apply to this event.

Please note:

1. Scores to be shot at Archery Ireland or World Archery events WA720 or WA1440 rounds
2. Athlete's must submit at least 2 scores from WA720 rounds or 1 from a WA1440 which meets the criteria above.
3. The last date for attaining the above scores is Sunday, 13th April
4. The qualifying period is 90 weeks prior to 13th April 2025 i.e. 23rd July 2023
5. Student archers qualifying on the basis of having attained the qualifying score in 2023 must demonstrate high levels of performance to the Team Manager or selection committee in the six months prior to the competition to secure a nomination to Student Sport Ireland.

Student Archer Selection

The Team Manager (and/or the Archery Ireland National Executive Committee) will nominate student archer(s) to Student Sport Ireland for consideration. Student Sport Ireland aided by the selection criteria outlined above and the student nomination forms submitted during the period of registration (April/May 2025), will review each student nomination individually and ratify her/his nomination as appropriate.

Ultimately the decision of whether a student archer is selected for participation at the Games rests with the Student Sport Ireland.

Eligibility

All students being considered to participate at the competition must meet the FISU and Student Sport Ireland Eligibility Criteria for International Competitions as published on the SSI web site: [Eligibility Criteria for International Competitions](#).

Age

Students must be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31st December of the year of the event (i.e. born between 01 January 2000 and 31st December 2007).

Funding/Costs

4.36 Student Sport Ireland will not be in a position to provide any funding to support athletes participating at the Games. Student Sport Ireland advice to all athletes being considered for selection for the Games is that while ultimately the cost of participation is the responsibility of the athlete the athlete's NGB will be expected to provide at least a third of each individual student's costs. In addition the athlete's college may be in a position to also support his/her participation

4.37 Student Sport Ireland advise that all athletes under consideration should approach their College Sports Officer at the earliest opportunity to indicate their interest in participating at the Games and to determine if the College may be in a position to support their participation;

4.38 All student balances must be settled 1 WEEK before departure for the Games. Failure to pay an outstanding balance before departure WILL result in Student Sport Ireland withdrawing a student's entry to participate at the Games;

4.39 Without exception, Student Sport Ireland will not facilitate payment of any fees and costs due until it first has received into its account all monies due.
